Issue relates to build 10240 Update server

Itself, I hope MS corrects it soon.

Immediate resolution:

- **Pro Users:** Click on Defer Upgrades-that would change your Windows update server and the problem would be resolved. However, upgrades would be postponed. Another Alternate Download version 1511 through media creation Tool and perform an In-place upgrade. This would make sure you are on the latest build of windows 10 and you would receive the Anniversary update due July this year.
- **Home users(Home+Home SL):** No defer upgrades option, the only thing is to download version 1511 through media creation tool.

Steps for upgrade:

Media creation Tool is now updated with Version 1511, OS Build 10586 of Windows 10.

You can select upgrade this PC now, windows should do that automatically for you.
